

PRODUCTION TEAM POSITION DESCRIPTIONS

SET DESIGNER, CONSTRUCTION CO-ORDINATOR & TEAM

Reports to the Production Manager

- 1. Attend creative team meetings and commence set planning ahead of rehearsal period
- 2. Design set in collaboration with director to fulfill their vision, prepare sketches, a look book or models for the director to approve
- 3. Ensure open lines of communication between designer, construction team and the director and choreographer to ensure the set is working for the show's requirements
- 4. Be prepared to creatively re-design any part of the concept that does not meet budget or blocking requirements
- 5. Prepare the rehearsal space using available resources so that the cast have a good sense of the final set
- 6. Prioritise use of available resources and stay within the allocated budget
- 7. Maintain an accurate record of all expenditure (including receipts)
- 8. Attend production meetings to report on progress and issues
- 9. Organise construction and painting working bees
- 10. Attend production meetings
- 11. Oversee the workplace health and safety requirements of all working bees and participants including safety and suitability of tools and equipment
- 12. Complete the post-production feedback survey in a timely manner
