GROUP AUDITIONS

Auditions are a competitive process. Some factors that may influence a casting decision include:

- 1. Preparation
- 2. Enthusiasm, and
- 3. Attitude (cooperation, demonstrating teamwork, supporting others).

These are variables that each candidate has full control of.

What to wear:	Clothing that allows for free movement.
Preparation:	You don't need to prepare a songs or any choreography for these auditions.

ACTIVITIES

Participants may be asked to engage in:

- A warm-up to get everyone physically and vocally prepared. This also helps the audition panel observe your focus, energy, and discipline.
- Activities that require teamwork, such as creating a scene or performing a group dance to assess how well they work with others.
- You may be asked to engage in improvisational exercises to demonstrate creativity, adaptability, and spontaneity.
- The panel may introduce challenges to observe your cooperation and problemsolving abilities.
- You may be asked to learn (in the room) and perform a short sequence of movement.
- Individuals might be called upon to showcase their natural or learned abilities, such as reading for a particular part, singing, or movement skills.

WHAT WE ARE LOOKING FOR

Some factors that the panel may be seeking in audition candidates include:

Ability	Determined from the activities listed above.
Directability	Yes, we made this word up. It means your ability to take direction. The panel might give on-the-spot direction to see how well you can adapt and incorporate feedback.
X-factor	Charisma, confidence, and the ability to command attention is something that can help individuals stand out from the crowd
Director's vision	You have no control over this factor. This comes down to how well an individual fits within the Director's vision in terms of look, personality and performance.
Professionalism	Punctuality and attitude during the audition.

Over 18s	Anyone over the age of 18 who accepts a role must also provide their Working With Children Check.
Cast announcement	Is embargoed until BTC makes the cast announcement on Monday 23 September.
